Performance Evaluation Instruction Sheet



Read to students

“You are dispatched for a reported spill at the Acme Chemical Warehouse, which is located next to an interstate highway. It is 1600 hours on a hot, humid, overcast Friday afternoon in July. The temperature is 89 degrees F, the wind is from the west at 5mph and the humidity is 65%.

Upon arrival, the first unit reports a 55 gallon drum lying on its side at the rear of the building. There is a pool of liquid forming and the material is spreading slowly. It is reported that when an employee began to move the drum with a forklift, the drum began to leak. The worker is complaining of respiratory distress and burning eyes and skin. The product has a UN identification number of 1993.

The warehouse foreman has presented you with a material safety data sheet. All of your responders are trained to the Operations level.”
