(1) Requirements

(a) Candidate

1. A candidate must be physically able to perform the tasks associated with fire brigade training.
2. The minimum age requirement is 18 years.
3. Prior to certification, the candidate shall meet the general knowledge, skill, performance and additional requirement as set out in Chapter 4 of NFPA 472 or Chapter 4 of NFPA 1072.
4. The certification expires one (1) year from the date the person leaves the fire brigade.

(b) Instructor

1. This course must be taught by an instructor who has been certified by the Commission as a Fire Instructor.

(c) Facility

1. This course will be taught at a facility which is in possession of minimum resources required for at least temporary approval.

(d) Examination

~~1. The instructor shall administer to the candidate a written test prepared and distributed to the instructor by the Commission at the end of each subject area of the course. The candidate must perform successfully on each subject area examination.~~

The practical skills identified in the Fire Brigade Teaching Outline for this level of training should be utilized by the candidate and by the instructor to prepare the candidate to the level required to meet competency standards identified in the Teaching Outline either as specified levels of excellence and/or time evaluation.
