Section 2: Applies knowledge of fire behavior, flow paths, and hostile fire events. Ensures fuel loads are appropriately configured or confirmed for the live fire training objective. Recognizes changing conditions and responds accordingly. (7.3.1) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explains expected fire conditions based on the planned evolution (4 points) • Describes and ensures students can recognize potential hostile fire events (4 points) • Verifies participants' understanding of emergency procedures in the case of unexpected fire conditions (evacuation signals, mayday procedures, etc.) (5 points) 	___/13	___/13
Section 3: Supervises a group of participants properly during a live fire evolution, utilizing proper supervision techniques, accountability procedures, and proper fire suppression operations. Ensures conditions are monitored throughout the evolution.
