- Firefighter I/II (preferred at time of hire)
- Alabama Paramedic or EMT license (preferred at time of hire)
- High School Diploma/GED or Equivalent
- Able to pass requirement physical for Firefighters and all other CVFD pre-employment requirements, including background check and drug screen
- Possess a valid Alabama driver license
- Able to comply with CVFD appearance & grooming standards
